### How to use this

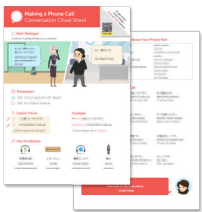
Using this workbook is simple. Simply write out the words and phrases on the lines below. Remember, you can write out each entry multiple times and also print multiple copies for extra practice.
