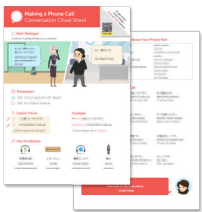
Using this workbook is simple. Simply write out the words and phrases on the lines below. Remember, you can write out each entry multiple times and also print multiple copies for extra practice.

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## 12 Korean Sentence Patterns

These example sentences use the most common and basic grammar patterns for beginners. There are 3 sentences per pattern. Write them out to get used to the patterns. If you want to master Grammar in more detail, [get a Korean Textbook on Amazon](#).

### Subject Verb Object

I eat apples. / 나는 사과를 먹는다. / Naneun sagwaleul meokneunda.



You read a book. / 당신은 책을 읽습니다. / Dangsineun chaeg-eul ilgseubnida.

He plays soccer. / 그는 축구를 합니다. / Geuneun chugguleul habnida.



## Present Tense

I am happy. / 나는 행복하다. / Naneun haengbokhada.



It is raining. / 비가 온다. / Biga onda.

The cat sleeps. / 고양이가 잔다. / Goyang-iga janda.

## Past Tense

I went home. / 나는 집에 갔다. / Naneun jib-e gasdda.

They watched a movie. / 그들은 영화를 봤다. /  
Geudeul-eun yeonghwaleul bwassda.

She bought a dress. / 그녀는 드레스를 샀다. / Geunyeoneun deuleseuleul  
sassda.

## Present Continuous

I am eating. / 나는 먹고 있다. / Naneun meokgo itda.

We are studying. / 우리는 공부하고 있다. / Ulineun gongbuhago itda.

You are singing. / 당신은 노래하고 있다. / Dangsineun nolaehago itda.



## Questions

Are you coming? / 당신은 오고 있니? / Dangsin-eun ogo itni?



What is this? / 이것은 무엇입니까? / Igeos-eun mueos-ibnikka?

Where is the bathroom? / 화장실 어디예요? / Hwajangsil eodieyo?

## Saying you like something

I like pizza. / 나는 피자를 좋아한다. / Naneun pijaleul joh-ahanda.

She likes flowers. / 그녀는 꽃을 좋아한다. / Geunyeoneun kkoch-eul joh-ahanda.

They like music. / 그들은 음악을 좋아한다. / Geudeul-eun eumag-eul joh-ahanda.

## Saying you don't like something

I don't like bananas. / 나는 바나나를 싫어한다. / Naneun bananaleul silh-eohanda.

He doesn't like carrots. / 그는 당근을 싫어한다. /  
Geuneun danggeun-eul silh-eohanda.



You don't like coffee. / 당신은 커피를 싫어합니다. /  
Dangsin-eun keopileul silh-eohabnida.



## Negative Statements

I am not a student. / 나는 학생이 아니다. / Naneun haks-aeng-i anida.

It is not a dog. / 그것은 개가 아니다. / Geugeos-eun gae ga anida.

We are not late. / 우리는 늦지 않다. / Ulineun neu-ji an-hda.

## If then statements

If it rains, I will stay home. / 비가 오면, 나는 집에 머무를 것이다. /  
Biga omyeon, naneun jib-e meomul geosida.

If you study, you will pass. / 공부하면 통과할 것이다. /  
Gongbuhameyeon tonggwahal geosida.

If she comes, I will leave. / 그녀가 오면, 나는 떠날 것이다. /  
Geunyeoga omyeon, naneun tteonal geosida.

## Saying you need to do something

I need to sleep. / 나는 잠이 필요하다. / Naneun jam-i pilyohada.

You need to eat. / 당신은 먹어야 한다. / Dangs-in-eun meogeoya handa.



They need to work. / 그들은 일해야 한다. / Geudeul-eun ilhaeya handa.



### Asking where something is

Where is the station? / 역은 어디입니까? / Yeog-eun eodiibnikka?

Where is my bag? / 내 가방 어디예요? / Nae gabang eodieyo?

Where is the restaurant? / 식당 어디예요? / Sikdang eodieyo?

### Showing possession of someone

This is my book. / 이것은 내 책이다. / Igeos-eun nae chaegida.

That is her car. / 그것은 그녀의 차다. / Geugeos-eun geunyeoui chada.

Those are our houses. / 그것들은 우리 집이다. / Geugeosdeul-eun uli jibida.
