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12 Greek Sentence Patterns

Subject Verb Object

I eat an apple. (Τρώω ένα μήλο.) - Troo ena milo.



She reads a book. (Διαβάζει ένα βιβλίο.) - Diavazi ena vivlio.



He drives a car. (Οδηγεί ένα αυτοκίνητο.) - Odigee ena aftokinito.



Present Tense

I work every day. (Εργάζομαι κάθε μέρα.) - Ergazome kathe mera.



She dances beautifully. (Χορεύει όμορφα.) - Chorevi omorfa.



They play soccer. (Παίζουν ποδόσφαιρο.) - Pezoun podozfero.



Past Tense

I visited Athens last summer. (Επισκέφθηκα την Αθήνα το περασμένο καλοκαίρι.) - Episkefthika tin Athina to perasmeno kalokairi.



She watched a movie yesterday. (Είδε ένα θεατρικό χθες.) - Ide ena theatriko chthes.



We traveled to Italy last year. (Ταξιδέψαμε στην Ιταλία πέρυσι.) - Taxidepsame stin Italia perusi.



Present Continuous

I am studying now. (Διαβάζω τώρα.) - Diavazo tora.



They are eating dinner. (Τρώνε δείπνο.) - Trone depno.



She is running in the park. (Τρέχει στο πάρκο.) - Trechei sto parko.



Questions

Do you like pizza? (Σου αρέσει η πίτσα;) - Sou aresei i pizza?



Where is the museum? (Πού είναι το μουσείο;) - Pou einai to mouseio?



What time is it? (Τι ώρα είναι;) - Ti ora einai?



Saying you like something

I like ice cream. (Μου αρέσει το παγωτό.) - Mou aresei to pagoto.



She enjoys reading. (Απολαμβάνει την ανάγνωση.) - Apolamvani tin anagnosi.



They love music. (Αγαπούν τη μουσική.) - Agaroun ti mousiki.



Saying you don't like something

I don't like spinach. (Δεν μου αρέσει ο σπανάκι.) - Den mou aresei o spanaki.



He dislikes rainy days. (Δεν του αρέσουν οι βροχερές μέρες.) - Den tou aresoun oi vrocheres meres.



We're not fans of horror movies. (Δεν είμαστε φαν των τρομακτικών ταινιών.) - Den eimaste fan ton tromaktikon tenion.



Negative Statements

I cannot swim. (Δεν μπορώ να κολυμπήσω.) - Den boro na kolimbiso.



He doesn't have a pet. (Δεν έχει κατοικίδιο.) - Den echei katoikidio.



They won't come to the party. (Δεν θα έρθουν στο πάρτι.) - Den tha erthoun sto parti.



If then statements

If it rains, I will stay home. (Αν βρέξει, θα μείνω σπίτι.) - An vrexei, tha meino spiti.



If you study hard, you will succeed. (Αν μελετήσεις σκληρά, θα πετύχεις.) - An meletisis sklira, tha petycheis.



If they call me, I will answer. (Αν με πάνε, θα απαντήσω.) - An me pane, tha apantiso.



Saying you need to do something

I need to buy groceries. (Χρειάζομαι να αγοράσω τρόφιμα.) - Chreiazome na agoraso trofima.



She has to finish her homework. (Πρέπει να τελειώσει τα μαθήματά της.) - Prepei na teleiosei ta mathimata tis.



They must clean the room. (Πρέπει να καθαρίσουν το δωμάτιο.) - Prepei na katharison to domatio.



Asking where something is

Where is the bathroom? (Πού είναι το μπάνιο;) - Που είναι το banio?



Can you tell me where the nearest pharmacy is? (Μπορείς να μου πεις πού είναι η πλησιέστερη φαρμακείο;) - Boreis na mou peis pou einai i plisieresteri farmakeio?



I wonder where my keys are. (Αναρωτιέμαι πού είναι τα κλειδιά μου.) - Anarotiemai pou einai ta kleidia mou.



Showing possession of someone

This is my brother's car. (Αυτό είναι το αυτοκίνητο του αδελφού μου.) - Afto einai to aftokinito tou adelfou mou.



Her house is beautiful. (Το σπίτι της είναι όμορφο.) - To spiti tis einai omorfo.



Their cat is playful. (Ο γάτος τους είναι παιχνιδιάρης.) - O gatous tous einai pechnidiaris.



Oh, you made it to the end you sneaky little rascal.

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
