1. Present tense verbs/actions

I eat.

Io mangio.



She reads.

Lei legge.

2. Past tense actions/verbs

I ate.

3. Talking about the future

I will eat.

4. Present continuous. Ongoing action.

I am running.

5. Past Continuous. Action that was ongoing in the past.

He was eating.

Stava mangiando.



They were cooking.

Stavano cucinando.

She can understand.

He can speak English.

Può parlare inglese.



7. Comparing things/comparatives

I am taller than him.

Sono più alto di lui.



She is smarter than me.

È più intelligente di me.



Apples are juicier than pears. Le mele sono più succose delle pere.



8. If/then statements

If it rains, I'll stay.

Se piove, starò.



If she calls, tell me.

Se chiama, dimmelo.



If you help, I'll be happy.

Se aiuto, sarò felice.

The ball was kicked by him.

La palla è stata calciata da lui.



The cake was baked by her.

La torta le fu cotta da lei.



The book was read by me.

Il libro è stato letto da me.

I don't eat meat.

Non mangio carne.



He does not sleep.

Non dorme.



She does not laugh.

Non ride.



18. Saying what you need/must do.

I need to learn English.

Ho bisogno di imparare l'inglese.



I must sleep.

Devo dormire.



You need to study.

Devi studiare.
