Subject Verb Object

I eat apples. / りんごを食べます。/ Ringo o tabemasu.



You read a book. / 本を読みます。/ Hon o yomimasu.



He plays soccer. / サッカーをします。/ Sakkā o shimasu.



Present Tense

I am happy. / 私は幸せです。/ Watashi wa shiawase desu.



It is raining. / 雨が降っています。/ Ame ga futteimasu.

Past Tense

I went home. / 家に帰りました。/ le ni kaerimashita.



They watched a movie. / 彼らは映画を見ました。/ Karera wa eiga o mimashita.



She bought a dress. / 彼女はドレスを買いました。/ Kanojo wa doresu o kaimashita.



Present Continuous

I am eating. / 食べています。/ Tabeteimasu.



We are studying. / 勉強しています。/ Benkyō shiteimasu.



You are singing. / 歌っています。/ Utatteimasu.



Questions

Are you coming? / 来ますか?/ Kimasu ka?



What is this? / これは何ですか? / Kore wa nan desu ka?



Where is the bathroom? / トイレはどこですか? / Toire wa doko desu ka?



Saying you like something

I like pizza. / ピザが好きです。/ Piza ga suki desu.



She likes flowers. / 彼女は花が好きです。/ Kanojo wa hana ga suki desu.



They like music. / 彼らは音楽が好きです。/ Karera wa ongaku ga suki desu.



Saying you don't like something

I don't like bananas. / バナナが好きではありません。/ Banana ga suki de wa arimasen.



He doesn't like carrots. / 彼は人参が好きではありません。/ Kare wa ninjin ga suki de wa arimasen.



You don't like coffee. / コーヒーが好きではない。/ Kōhī ga suki de wa nai.



Negative Statements

I am not a student. / 私は学生ではありません。/ Watashi wa gakusei de wa arimasen.



It is not a dog. / 犬ではありません。/ Inu de wa arimasen.



We are not late. / 遅くないです。/ Osokunai desu.



If then statements

If it rains, I will stay home. / 雨が降ったら、家にいます。/ Ame ga futtara, ie ni imasu.



If you study, you will pass. / 勉強したら、合格します。/ Benkyō shitara, gōkaku shimasu.



If she comes, I will leave. / 彼女が来たら、出ます。/ Kanojo ga kitara, demasu.



Saying you need to do something

I need to sleep. / 眠る必要があります。/ Neru hitsuyō ga arimasu.



You need to eat. / 食べる必要があります。/ Taberu hitsuyō ga arimasu.



They need to work. / 働く必要があります。/ Hataraku hitsuyō ga arimasu.



Asking where something is

Where is the station? / 駅はどこですか? / Eki wa doko desu ka?



Where is my bag? / 私のバッグはどこですか?/ Watashi no baggu wa doko desu ka?



Where is the restaurant? / レストランはどこですか? / Resutoran wa doko desu ka?



Showing possession of someone

This is my book. / これは私の本です。/ Kore wa watashi no hon desu.



That is her car. / それは彼女の車です。/ Sore wa kanojo no kuruma desu.



Those are our houses. / それらは私たちの家です。/ Sorera wa watashitachi no ie desu.
