I eat.

Yo como.



She reads.

### 4. Present continuous. Ongoing action.

I am running.

### 5. Past Continuous. Action that was ongoing in the past.

I was sleeping.

Estaba durmiendo.



He was eating.

Él estaba comiendo.



They were cooking.

Estaban cocinando.



## 6. Saying what you're able to do

I am able to swim.

Puedo nadar.



She can understand.

Ella puede entender.



He can speak English.

El puede hablar inglés.



## 7. Comparing things/comparatives

I am taller than him.

Soy más alto que él.



She is smarter than me.

Ella es más inteligente que yo.



Apples are juicier than pears.

Las manzanas son más jugosas que las peras.



## 8. If/then statements

If it rains, I'll stay.

Si llueve, me quedaré.



If she calls, tell me.

Si ella llama, dime.



If you help, I'll be happy.

Si ayudas, seré feliz.

The ball was kicked by him.

La pelota fue pateada por él.



The cake was baked by her.

El pastel fue horneado por ella.



The book was read by me.

El libro fue leído por mí.

Necesitas estudiar.
