1. Present tense verbs/actions

I eat.

Jag äter.



She reads.

2. Past tense actions/verbs

I ate.

3. Talking about the future

I will eat.

4. Present continuous. Ongoing action.

5. Past Continuous. Action that was ongoing in the past.

6. Saying what you're able to do

I am able to swim.

She can understand.

Hon kan förstå.



He can speak English.

Han kan tala engelska.



7. Comparing things/comparatives

I am taller than him.

Jag är högre än honom.



She is smarter than me.

Hon är smartare än jag.



Apples are juicier than pears. Äpplen är saftigare än päron.



8. If/then statements

If it rains, I'll stay.

Om det regnar stannar jag.



If she calls, tell me.

Om hon ringer, berätta för mig.



If you help, I'll be happy.

Om du hjälper, blir jag lycklig.



9. Passive Voice

The ball was kicked by him.

Bollen sparkades av honom.



The cake was baked by her.
