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## 18+ Indonesian Sentence Patterns

### 1. Present tense verbs/actions

I eat.

Saya makan.



She reads.

Dia membaca.



He laughs.

Dia tertawa.



### 2. Past tense actions/verbs

I ate.

Saya makan.



He played.

Dia bermain.



They drank.

Mereka minum.



### 3. Talking about the future

I will eat.

Saya akan makan.



You will play.

Anda akan bermain.



It will rain.

Akan hujan.



### 4. Present continuous. Ongoing action.

I am running.

Saya sedang berlari.



She is singing.

Dia bernyanyi.



They are laughing.

Mereka tertawa.



### 5. Past Continuous. Action that was ongoing in the past.

I was sleeping.

Saya lagi tidur.



He was eating.

Dia sudah makan.



They were cooking.

Mereka sedang memasak.



## 6. Saying what you're able to do

I am able to swim.

Saya bisa berenang.



She can understand.

Dia bisa mengerti.



He can speak English.

Dia bisa berbicara bahasa Inggris.



## 7. Comparing things/comparatives

I am taller than him.

Saya lebih tinggi darinya.



She is smarter than me.

Dia lebih pintar dariku.



Apples are juicier than pears.    Apel lebih juicier dari pir.



## 8. If/then statements

If it rains, I'll stay.

Jika hujan, saya akan tinggal.



If she calls, tell me.

Jika dia menelepon, beri tahu saya.



If you help, I'll be happy.

Jika Anda membantu, saya akan bahagia.



## 9. Passive Voice

The ball was kicked by him.

Bola ditendang olehnya.



The cake was baked by her.

Kue itu dipanggang olehnya.



The book was read by me.

Buku itu dibacakan oleh saya.



## 10. Saying what you like

I like swimming.

Saya suka berenang.



You like to read.

Kamu suka membaca.



They like to travel.

Mereka suka bepergian.
