12 Persian Sentence Patterns

Subject Verb Object

He reads books. او کتابها را میخواند. (Ou ketābhā rā mikhwānd.)

She eats fruits. او میوهها را میخورد. (Ou mivehhā rā mikhorad.)

They watch movies. آنها فیلمها را میبینند. (Ānhā filmhā rā mibinand.)

Present Tense	
	I speak English. من انگلیسی صحبت می‌کنم. (Man englisi sohbat mikonam.)
	You work hard. تو سخت کار می‌کنی. (To sakht kār mikoni.)
	We live here. ما اینجا زندگی می‌کنیم. (Mā injā zendegi mikonim.)
Past Tense	
	He visited the museum. او به موزه سفر کرد. (Ou be mūze safar kard.)
	She cooked dinner. او شام پخت. (Ou shām pakht.)
	They finished their homework. آنها تکالیف خود را تمام کردند. (Ānhā takālif-e khod rā tamām kardand.)
Present Continuous	
	I am reading a book. من کتابی می‌خوانم. (Man ketābi mikhwānam.)
	You are eating lunch. تو ناهار می‌خوری. (To nāhār mikhorī.)
	We are watching TV. ما تلویزیون می‌بینیم. (Mā television mibinim.)

	Questions
	Are you coming? آیا می آید؟ (Āyā miāyid?)
	What is your name? نام شما چیست؟ (Nām-e shomā chist?)
	How old are you? چند سالتان است؟ (Chand sāltān-est?)
	Saying you like something
	I like ice cream. من بستنی دوست دارم. (Man bastani dust dāram.)
	She likes swimming. او شنا کردن را دوست دارد. (Ou shenā kardan rā dust dārad.)
	They like playing soccer. آن‌ها بازی فوتبال کردن را دوست دارند. (Ānhā bāzi-e futbāl kardan rā dust dārand.)
	Saying you don't like something
	I don't like broccoli. من براکلی دوست ندارم. (Man broccoli dust nadāram.)
	She doesn't like horror movies. او از فیلم‌های ترسناک خوشش نمی آید. (Ou az filme-hā-ye tarsnak khoshesh nemiyād.)

	They don't like rainy days. آن‌ها روزهای بارانی را دوست ندارند. (Ānhā ruzhā-ye bārāni rā dust nadārand.)
	Negative Statements
	I am not tired. من خسته نیستم. (Man khaste nistam.)
	She is not hungry. او گرسنه نیست. (Ou gorsne nist.)
	They are not lost. آن‌ها گم نشده‌اند. (Ānhā gom nashode-and.)
	If then statements
	If it rains, we'll stay home. اگر بیارد، در خانه می‌مانیم. (Agar babard, dar khāneh mimānim.)
	If you study hard, you'll succeed. اگر سخت درس بخوانی، موفق می‌شوی. (Agar sakht dars bokhani, mofaq mishavi.)
	If they come early, we'll start the meeting. اگر زود بیایند، جلسه را شروع می‌کنیم. (Agar zood biayand, jalseh rā shoro mikonim.)
	Saying you need to do something
	I need to buy groceries. من باید خرید مواد غذایی کنم. (Man bāyad khared-e mavad-e ghazāyi konam.)

	You need to rest. تو باید استراحت کنی. (To bāyad estrāhat koni.)
	We need to finish the project. ما باید پروژه را تمام کنیم. (Mā bāyad proje rā tamām konim.)
	Asking where something is
	Where is the library? کتابخانه کجاست؟ (Ketābkhāneh kojāst?)
	Where is the bathroom? دستشویی کجاست؟ (Dastshoyi kojāst?)
	Where is your car? ماشین شما کجاست؟ (Māshin-e shomā kojāst?)
	Showing possession of someone
	This is my sister. این خواهر من است. (In khāhar-e man ast.)
	That is his cat. این گربه اوست. (In gorbe-e oust.)
	These are our children. این فرزندان ما هستند. (In farzandān-e mā hastand.)
